

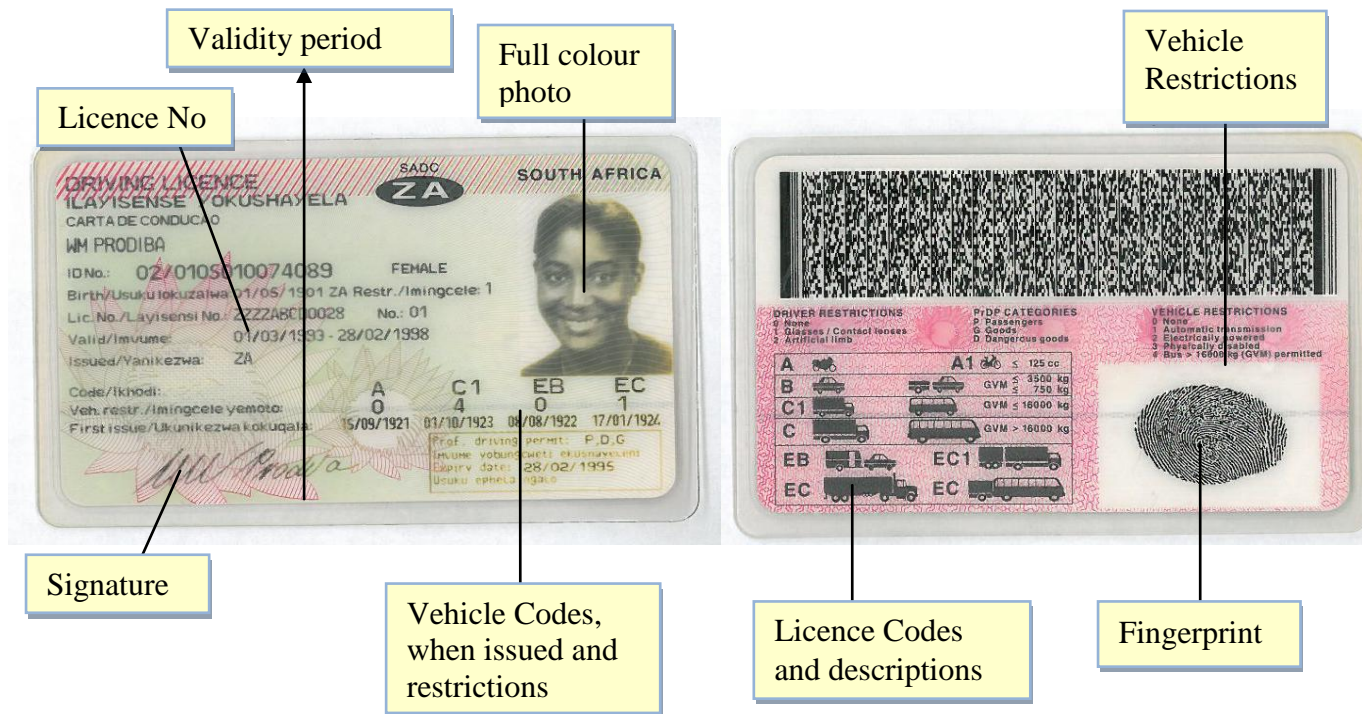
## Validity Update

The 1949 and 1926 IDPs are valid for one year from date of issue, provided that your South African drivers licence is valid for that same period. The 1968 permit is the only permit that is valid for three years and therefore your South African drivers licence would need to be valid for the same period of IDP validity

However, if your South African drivers licence is due to expire before the expiry date on the permit, then the IDP will only be made valid up to expiry date as appears on the SA drivers licence. Should the client subsequently obtain a new valid SA drivers licence, we can then issue a new IDP to replace existing IDP and make it valid for 1 year from date of issue on the first IDP.

### Reasons

- An IDP is issued according to the licence you have at time of application
- Each time you renew your South African drivers licence, the licence number on the card changes. Therefore the permit needs to be changed.

After the client has obtained a new valid SA drivers licence, we can then issue a new permit to replace the first permit. NB – date of issue must remain the same as date of issue on first permit then expiry date is determined by date of issue.
